ARCHITECTURE AND TOURISM.

The PhD proposes to deepen tools and methods finalized to the study of urbanized territories. The intent is to use the project as transformation tool for an improvement of qualities of the architectural and urban spaces.

“Architecture and Tourism” is the general thematic where single researches will place and conduct during 3 years of study.

Tourist phenomenon produces evident effects on the territory. The tourist spaces, originally polarized and inclusive, are becoming more extensive and pervasive, influencing contemporary practices.

With the multi-disciplinary competences of this curriculum (town and architectural design, history of architecture and urbanism), PhD intends to analyze the evolution and critic points of the tourist phenomenon.
